Spartanburg County contributes to the operational cost of the following organizations providing needed social services. (Agency)

Program and Services

- Children's Boarding Home - Provides clothing, medicine, school fees, and transportation for children in Foster Care/Preventive Services.
- Big Brothers/Big Sisters – Provides personnel services through the Big Brothers/Big Sisters program in Spartanburg County.
- Special Family Emergency Fund - Provides emergency medical, fuel, utilities, clothing and food expenses for County clients.
- Safe Homes/Rape Crisis Network – Provides temporary, emergency shelter to abused persons and their children.
- Spartanburg Children’s Shelter – Provides non-federal portion of operating expenses for childcare through the Department of Social Services.
- Children’s Advocacy Center – Provides advocacy services for abused children.
