Benefits to Residents, Visitors, Businesses, or County Employees

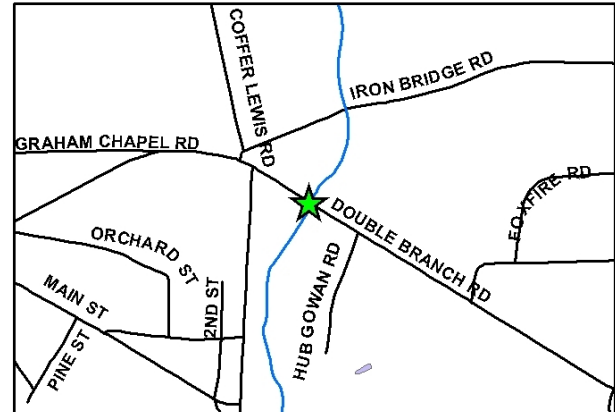
Stabilizing this bridge will ensure motorist safety, as well as increase the capacity to handle larger vehicles.
