There will be a **PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD May 14 - May 21, 2009.**

Citizens are encouraged to examine and comment on the proposed budget and project amendment during regular business hours and at the public hearing. Documents will be available at the above address and Spartanburg County Public library. All comments must be received by the end of the public hearing on May 21, 2009 in the Community Development Office. ## AMENDMENT TO ANNUAL ACTION PLAN: FY2008

### 1. Chesnee Mill Village Water Project

*These funds will be used by the Liberty-Chesnee-Fingerville Water District to provide improved community water distribution infrastructure facilities to a LMI (low-moderate income) community. This project will benefit approximately 125 households.*

➤ **Amendment: Add this activity to CDBG FY08 funding \$135,000.00.**

### 2. Fingerville Mill Village Water Project

*These funds will be used by the Liberty-Chesnee-Fingerville Water District to provide improved community water distribution infrastructure facilities to a LMI (low-moderate income) community. This project will benefit approximately 50 household.*

➤ **Amendment: Add this activity to CDBG FY08 funding \$85,000.00.**

### 3. Browning Road Water Project

*These funds will be used by the Meansville-Riley Water Company to make available safe, clean drinking water to 14 LMI (low-moderate income) households in an area where wells have dried up.*

➤ **Amendment: Add this activity to CDBG FY08 funding \$93,548.30**
