Community Development Block Grant Program HOME Investment Partnerships Program General Fund Funding Opportunities

Spartanburg County announces the availability of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), and General Fund funds to undertake projects in the areas of Housing, Economic Development, Community Infrastructure, and Health and Human Services. Requests involving federal funds must serve low and moderate income areas or persons in Spartanburg County. Opportunities are also available for Environmental and Conservation, and Arts and Cultural projects.

For organizations requesting Accommodations Tax Funding, applications will be made available online in January 2010.

- All funding request applications must be submitted to the Community Development Department by 5:00 PM, Friday, January 8, 2010.

- We strongly recommend all applicants visit the website as soon as possible to allow time to sufficiently complete the application and request any technical assistance.

Preliminary notification of recommended funding allocations for General Fund will be made in April 2010. Public Hearing on recommendations for Funding Allocations for CDBG and HOME will be held in March. Appropriations will be made in July after the County receives approval from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and County Council adopts the annual operating budget.
