Steps for Traffic Calming Program

1. Make official application with the Spartanburg County Planning and Development Department. This step MUST be completed BEFORE the process can proceed.
2. Traffic Calming Program staff contacts Sheriff's Office to request increased patrol.
3. Determination of road/street's eligibility for traffic calming devices.
4. Neighborhood invited to circulate petition. Forms and information regarding required number of signatures will be provided by Traffic Calming staff.
5. Determination as to whether stepped-up Sheriff's patrol alleviated problem.
6. Petition submitted by neighborhood. Staff verifies petition.
7. Public Works conducts traffic analysis.
8. Decision made by Traffic Calming Program staff as to whether affected road qualifies for program.
9. Traffic calming design, speed hump and signage placement approved by neighborhood.
10. Traffic calming solution installed.
