

PROPOSED MATTHEW PERRY PARKWAY FROM S.C. ROUTE 295 TO JACKSON ROAD

Thursday, February 4, 2010, between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. at the Community Baptist Church, located at 297 Fuller Road, Spartanburg, SC 29306.

Purpose:

To provide project information, update, and to solicit comments from area residents regarding the proposed Matthew Perry Parkway which would extend from S.C. Route 295 (Southport Road) to Jackson Road. Personnel from Spartanburg County, the South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT), and their consultant will be available to discuss the project with interested citizens on an individual basis.

Format:

From 5:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m., the hearing format will be informal. Large aerial displays of the entire project will be available for viewing, and project team members from SCDOT will be present to discuss the project with interested citizens on an individual basis.

At 6:00 p.m., Project Representatives will make a brief, formal presentation about the project status and potential revisions. Immediately following the presentation, citizens will have the option to make formal, verbal comments regarding the proposed project. Anyone who wishes to verbally comment must sign up between 5:00 p.m. and 5:55 p.m. when entering the public hearing. Each comment will be limited to two minutes and may not be transferred. The informal portion of the public hearing will continue during this time.
