ADDENDA No. REVISIONS / CLARIFICATIONS

- (1) Spillman's Automated Field Reporting module will allow officers to complete forms from the field using a laptop computer, eliminating the need to return to the sheriff's office to file reports and allowing more time for community patrolling. The software will enable officers to increase their street-level presence, helping to reduce crime and maintain positive citizen relationships.

In addition to the requested Mobile Field Reporting module, CAD Interface and the Mobile software the Spartanburg County Sheriff's Office has already adopted and has in place Spillman's Records Management, Jail Management, Equipment Management, Personnel Management and Inventory Management software.

Using Spillman's Mobile law reporting the department will be able to input and store all data in a single database where it can be easily accessed by personnel throughout the agency. Spillman will allow the agency to eliminate the use of multiple databases and enable quick access to critical information.

Using Spillman's Field Interview reporting officers will be able to gather intelligence in real time updating the database with the most updated real

time data, to be used to solve crimes and develop suspects as well as acquaintances for potential reference points to develop suspects.

Using Spillman's Mobile Software officers from the field will be able to check warrants and wants from their vehicle for persons wanted not only in Spartanburg County but across the nation via access to the National Crime Information Center's database (NCIC) which includes not only outstanding wants and warrants but also will have the ability to check Violent gang/Terrorist associations, Multi state protection orders, Foreign fugitive's, multi state stolen property including vehicles, guns, tools, etc.

This is a collection of software modules that integrate to form a *single data base of information, Spillman is the developer and sole distributor of their software*
