MINUTES

Thursday, January 18, 2018
County Council Chambers
Spartanburg County Administration Building

A public meeting of the Spartanburg County Transportation Committee was held on Thursday, January 18, 2018 at 5:30 p.m. in the County Council Chambers, Spartanburg County Administration Building, 366 North Church Street, Spartanburg, South Carolina. Chairman Tom Arthur presided.

In compliance with the Freedom of Information Act, notices of this meeting were mailed and emailed in advance to county officials, local news media, citizens and other interested parties.

The following members were present: Tom Arthur, Travis Brown, Ed Memmot, Vic Bailey, IV, Ed Humphries, John Throckmorton, Will Gramling. The following members were absent: Ernestine Anderson, Foster Chapman, Dean Anderson.

1. Chairman Arthur called the meeting to order.

2. CTC Chest Morris' appointment to CTC -

Chet Morris, representing House District 35, CTC member has been absent for 3 or more consecutive meetings. According to CTC Policy a member cannot be absent for three consecutive meetings and continue to serve on the CTC.

Motion was made to dismiss Chet Morris, representing House District 35, from the CTC by John Throckmorton. Second was made by Ed Humphries. Motion carried.

3. Approval of Minutes - October 19, 2017

The minutes from the October 19, 2017 were presented to the committee for approval. Motion was made by John Throckmorton to approve the minutes as written. Second was made by Vic Bailey, IV. Motion carried.

4. Financial Report - Bradey

Chairman Tom Arthur gave the financial report in the absence of Lacey Bradey.

5. Project Status Report – Martin

1. a. 7022, Pacolet sidewalk installation Revising plans
b. 12018 Pacolet River Gateway Roundabout
c. 13010 Pacolet connect River Walk with road
d. 17006 Pacolet River passage Gateway project
2. 12008 Cannons Campground Road. Right of way acquisition firm has entered into negotiations with property owners.
3. 15006 4th Street. See Ron Kirby and Travis Brown.
4. 16006 Traffic signal at Drayton Mill. In constant contact with contractor. Work is supposed to begin any day now.
5. 16013 Genoble Road. Due to the city of Greer ownership problems and right of way problems this project is at a standstill.
6. 17005 Shoresbrook Drive. Considering adding this project to a much larger project package.
7. 17008 (18006S and 18007S) Roebuck Fire Department, replace concrete drive entrance. Have an agreement from the SCDOT that the contractor for this project would not have to be on the SCDOT approved contractor list. Will put project out for bid again.
8. 17009 Hwy. 14 Drainage Project. Out to bid.
9. 17015 Compton Bridge Road. Preparing project to go out to bid.
10. 17004 State Non-Recurring Funding. New Cut Road, only a little Thermo remains to be done. John Dodd Road. Minor punch list items and will be complete.
11. 18002L through 18005L Flatwoods Industrial. Reviewing plans. Goal is to have it out to bid this year with Construction next year.

6. Recommended Projects from the Advisory Committee – Brown

- a. Request #1116, Rep. Allison set-a-side, Victor Hill Road widening, in the amount of \$59,196. Steve Belue Fund in the amount of \$100,000. Carter Smith \$150,000.

Request is being made that Rep. Allison's set-a-side in the amount of \$59,196 be applied to widen a portion of Victor Hill Road in Greer as part of an economic development project. A request is being made to Spartanburg County Council for \$100,000 of the Steve Belue Fund and Carter Smith is contributing \$150,000. The total project cost is \$309,000.

Motion was made by Travis Brown to approve Rep. Allison's set-a-side in the amount of \$59,196. Second was made by John Throckmorton. Motion carried.

- b. Request #1117, Rep. Magnuson set-a-side, sidewalk installation along a portion of Bomar Avenue in the City of Landrum, in the amount of \$5,135 (20% of cost estimate \$25,675).

Request is being made for Rep. Magnuson set-a-side in the amount of \$5,135 be applied to install sidewalks on Bomar Avenue in the City of Landrum. The project cost estimate is \$25,675. The set-a-side amount if 20% of the cost estimate.

Motion was made by Travis Brown to approve Rep. Magnuson's set-a-side in the amount of \$5,135. Second was made by John Throckmorton and Will Gramling. Motion carried.

c. Lake Lyman Heights Road widening and striping. Project cost estimate is \$375,000. Developer is contributing \$100,000; request to Spartanburg County Council for Steve Belue Fund in the amount of \$93,511. Request for representatives set-a-side in the total amount of \$181,489:

1. Request #1118, Rep. Long set-a-side in the amount of \$12,726.

Motion was made by Travis Brown to approve Rep. Long's set-a-side in the amount of \$12,726. Second was made by Vic Bailey, IV. Motion carried.

2. Request #1119, Rep. Cole's set-a-side in the amount of \$13,618.

Motion was made by Travis Brown to approve Rep. Cole's set-a-side in the amount of \$13,618. Second was made by Ed Humphries. Motion carried.

3. Request #1120, Rep. Magnuson's set-a-side in the amount of \$60,750.

Motion was made by Travis Brown to approve Rep. Magnuson's set-a-side in the amount of \$60,750. Second was made by John Throckmorton. Motion carried.

4. Request #1121, Rep. Henderson-Myers set-a-side in the amount of \$64,395.

Motion was made by Travis Brown to approve Rep. Henderson-Myers set-a-side in the amount of \$64,395. Second was made by John Throckmorton. Motion carried.

5. Request #1122, Rep. Chumley's set-a-side in the amount of \$30,000.

Motion was made by Travis Brown to approve Rep. Chumley's set-a-side in the amount of \$30,000. Second was made by John Throckmorton. Motion carried.

d. Annual CTC Paving:

Below are the amounts to be approved for the Annual CTC paving. The City of Spartanburg will submit their paving list in April.

1. SCDOT - \$957,800 -

Motion was made by Travis Brown to approve the SCDOT's annual paving list in the amount of \$957,800. Second was made by John Throckmorton. Motion carried.

2. Spartanburg County \$1,527,300 -

Motion was made by Travis Brown to approve Spartanburg County's annual paving list in the amount of \$1,527,300. Second was made by Ed Humphries and John Throckmorton. Motion carried.

3. City of Greer - \$68,700

Motion was made by Travis Brown to approve the City of Greer's annual paving list in the amount of \$68,700. (50/50 match). Second was made by Ed Humphries. No vote was given by John Throckmorton. Motion carried.

4. City of Landrum - \$87,500 -

Motion was made by Travis Brown to approve the City of Landrum's annual paving list in the amount of \$87,500 (50/50 match). Second was made by Ed Memmot. Motion carried.

5. Town of Lyman - \$16,200 -

Motion was made by Travis Brown to approve the Town of Lyman's annual paving list in the amount of \$16,200 (50/50 match). Second was made by John Throckmorton. Motion carried.

6. Town of Reidville - \$64,400 -

Motion was made by Travis Brown to approve the Town of Reidville's annual paving list in the amount of \$64,400 (50/50 match). Second was made by Vic Baliey, IV. Motion carried.

e. 4th Street, road realignment/widening beginning at and including the intersection with Valley Falls Road and Hanging Rock Road, continuing west approximately to the intersection with Wilson Court. \$1,500,000.

Motion is being made by Travis Brown to approve funding in the amount of \$1,500,000 to be added to Project No. 15006L 4th Street road realignment/widening. Second was made by John Throckmorton. Motion carried.

7. Project #16013 Genoble Road widening. Remove from CTC list.

This project was approved at the April 21, 2016 CTC meeting. Due to no cooperation from the City of Greer the Advisory Committee is requesting that this project be removed from the CTC list and funds returned to the CTC general fund.

Motion was made by Travis Brown to remove project no. 16013 from the CTC list and return funds in the amount of \$60,000 to the CTC general fund. Second was made by John Throckmorton. Vic Bailey, IV abstained from vote. Motion carries by a majority vote.
