



# MINUTES

## County Council Meeting

### General Session

Monday, January 28, 2019

Spartanburg County Council met on Monday, January 28, 2019, in the County Council Chambers of the County Administrative Office Building. The following were in attendance: Honorable Manning Lynch, Chairman; Honorables Michael Brown, Jack Mabry, David Britt, Whitney Farr, Bob Walker, and Roger Nutt, Council Members; along with Cole Alverson, County Administrator; Jim Hipp, Deputy County Administrator; John Harris, County Attorney; and Ginny Dupont, County Attorney. In compliance with the Freedom of Information Act, notice of this meeting was provided in advance to the local news media and other interested parties.

- I. Chairman Lynch called the meeting to order.
- II. There were no items requiring a vote following Executive Session. No Executive Session was held at this meeting.
- III. Chairman Lynch stated it came to his attention late Friday afternoon, January 25, 2019 that some members of Council had some things they wanted to look at in the Council Rules, and Mr. Lynch also had some things as well after further reflection. Mr. Lynch then asked Mr. Farr to make a motion. Council is going to put this matter off and have a Work Session at the next meeting in February to go over the proposed changes. Mr. Lynch requested the proposed changes by email by Monday, February 4, 2019. Motion made by Mr. Farr to postpone the adoption of the Council Rules and Procedures and carryover the current Council Rules and Procedures adopted by the prior County Council until March of 2019 County Council meeting. Motion seconded by Mr. Britt and carried. No vote was recorded for Mr. Lynch.
- IV. Motion made by Mr. Nutt to nominate Mr. Britt to serve as Vice-Chairman for a one year term. Motion seconded by Mr. Mabry. Mr.


Brown stated that he has not kept track of the order, and he did not know who would have been in this process next in line. Mr. Brown also stated that he understands that it is up to the Chairman's position. Motion carried. Mr. Farr opposed. No vote was recorded for Mr. Brown and Mr. Lynch.

- V. Motion made by Mr. Britt to waive rules and nominate and elect Mr. Lynch, Mr. Mabry, and Mr. Nutt to serve on the Appalachian Council of Governments Board. Motion seconded by Mr. Brown and carried. No vote was recorded for Mr. Lynch.
  
- VI. Chairman Lynch asked that Mr. Walker remain on the SPATS (Spartanburg Area Transportation System) Board if he would like to stay on there. Motion made by Mr. Britt to nominate and elect Mr. Walker to the SPATS (Spartanburg Area Transportation System) Board. Motion seconded by Mr. Nutt and carried. No vote was recorded for Mr. Lynch. Mr. Lynch stated that by position Mr. Nutt, Public Works, Buildings and Grounds Committee Chairman and Mr. Lynch, County Council Chairman, will also serve on the SPATS Board.
  
- VII. Motion made by Mr. Britt to waive rules, nominate and appoint Paul E. (Eddie) Dearybury, to the Board of Assessment Appeals. Motion seconded by Mr. Nutt and carried. Motion made by Mr. Britt to waive rules, nominate and appoint Bob Tillotson, Financing of Real Estate, to the Board of Assessment Appeals. Motion seconded by Mr. Mabry and carried. Motion made by Mr. Walker to waive rules, nominate and appoint Jerry Allen Gaines, II, At Large, to the Spartanburg County Planning Commission. Motion seconded by Mr. Britt and carried. Motion made by Mr. Brown to waive rules, nominate and appoint Maceo Black, Jr. to the Una Community Fire Service Area Board. Motion seconded by Mr. Britt and carried. Motion made by Mr. Brown to waive rules, nominate and appoint James D. Dills to the Una Community Fire Service Area Board. Motion seconded by Mr. Britt and carried. Motion made by Mr. Brown to waive rules, nominate and appoint Renee Hughes Hawkins to the Una Community Fire Service Area Board. Motion seconded by Mr. Britt and carried. No vote was recorded for Mr. Lynch on the Board Appointments.
