Spartanburg County Council met on Monday, March 20, 2023, at 3:30 p.m. in Conference Room Two of the County Administrative Office Building. III. Motion made by Ms. Coker at 5:20 p.m. to adjourn Executive Session. Motion seconded by Mr. McCorkle and carried.


