



County Council Committee Minutes

Public Works, Buildings & Grounds Committee April 15, 2019

The Public Works, Buildings & Grounds Committee of Spartanburg County Council met on Monday, April 15, 2019, in County Council Chambers of the County Administrative Office Building. In compliance with the Freedom of Information Act, notice of this meeting was provided in advance to the local news media and other interested parties. The following were in attendance: Chairman Roger Nutt; and Honorables Manning Lynch and Jack Mabry, Committee Members; along with Honorables Michael Brown, David Britt, Whitney Farr, and Bob Walker, Council Members. Also attending were Cole Alverson, County Administrator; Jim Hipp, Deputy County Administrator; John Harris, County Attorney; and Ginny Dupont, County Attorney. .

Chairman Nutt called the meeting to order.

II.

- A. Ms. Jes Sdao, Recycling Coordinator, presented information in reference to an Annual Solid Waste grant application to help maintain **Tire Recycling Management Program**. The SC-DHEC Tire Grant provides funding for advertising for the tire recycling program and professional development. The funding request is for \$4,750. This grant also provides funding for other direct costs to help manage the tire recycling program. This includes a request for \$8,000 to be used to purchase a cage trailer to transport tires and other waste from events. This also includes a request for \$42,798.99 for contractor costs to offset overage from the cost of recycling tires. The total requested is \$55,548.99. There is no County match required. Motion made by Mr. Mabry to approve submittal of the grant application. Motion seconded by Mr. Lynch and carried.
- B. Ms. Jes Sdao, Recycling Coordinator, presented information in reference to an Annual Solid Waste grant application to promote the **Waste Oil Recycling Program**. The SC-DHEC Waste Oil Grant provides funding for advertising associated with the motor oil recycling program and professional development. The funding request is for \$4,750. This grant also provides funding for equipment and supplies, as well as direct and indirect costs associated with the Motor Oil Recycling Program. This includes a request for \$4,000 for oil spill kits and \$1,900 for 55 gallon drums to collect contaminated oil. The total

requested is \$10,650. There is no County match required. Motion made by Mr. Mabry to approve submittal of the grant application. Motion seconded by Mr. Lynch and carried.

- C. Ms. Jes Sdao, Recycling Coordinator, presented information in reference to a **Solid Waste grant application to help grow the Recycling Program** to increase participation, tonnage, revenue, and commodities accepted. The SC-DHEC Solid Waste Grant provides funding for equipment and supplies, and other innovations to grow our recycling program to meet DHEC's 40% goal of recycling participation. The funding request is for \$7,000 for Rubbermaid roll carts and \$6,750 for tilt trucks. The total requested is \$13,750. There is no County match required. Motion made by Mr. Mabry to approve submittal of the grant application. Motion seconded by Mr. Lynch and carried.
