## County Council Meeting

### Executive Session

Spartanburg County Council met on Monday, April 17, 2023, at 4:00 p.m. in Conference Room Two of the County Administrative Office Building. The following were in attendance: Honorable Manning Lynch, Chairman; Honorables Monier Abusoft, Jack Mabry, David Britt, Bob Walker, and Jessica Coker, Council Members; along with Cole Alverson, County Administrator; Earl Alexander, Deputy County Administrator; Kevin Stiens, Assistant County Administrator; John Harris, County Attorney; and Ryan Gaylord, Deputy County Attorney.   - D. Staff has asked to discuss with Council contractual terms associated with a memorandum of understanding with a developer for a possible partnership with the County.
