

# ***Spartanburg County Transportation Committee***

## **MINUTES**

A public meeting of the Spartanburg County Transportation Committee was held on Tuesday, May 22, 2018, at 5:30 p.m. in Conference Room 1, Upper Level of the Spartanburg County Administration Building, 366 North Church Street, Spartanburg, SC. Chairman Tom Arthur presided.

In compliance with the Freedom of Information Act, notices of this meeting were mailed and emailed in advance to county officials, local news media, citizens and other interested parties.

The following members were present: Tom Arthur, Travis Brown, Vic Bailey, IV, Kyle Owings, Dean Anderson, John Throckmorton, and Will Gramling. The following members were absent: Ed Humphries (Excused), Ed Memmot and Ernestine Anderson.

### **1. Call to Order - Tom Arthur, Chairman**

Chairman Arthur called the meeting to order and introduced new member Kyle Owings representing House District 33.

### **2. New Business**

Update on Project #18013; 18014; 18015; 18016; 18017, Lake Lyman Heights Road - Travis Brown, Chairman, CTC Technical Advisory Committee and Public Works Director.

Chairman Arthur began by explaining that the meeting was called for the CTC Committee to review project nos. 18013; 18014; 18015; 18016 and 18017 Lake Lyman Heights Road Widening and to determine if the committee is still in agreement that this is a viable project. Mr. Arthur reported that the project had two additional funding sources, The Steve Belue Fund that is managed by Spartanburg County Council and private funds from the developer.

Travis Brown, Chairman of the CTC Advisory Committee, gave a power point presentation describing the scope of the project which includes widening the entire length of Lake Lyman Heights Road to at least 18', enough for two cars to pass, and install pavement markers. Mr. Brown reported that the present condition of the road is a safety hazard and that eventually Spartanburg County will have to pave this road and the construction cost will continue to increase until then. If the project is done now the County will receive \$100,000 to offset the cost.

Chairman Arthur and Mr. Brown agreed that there were no concerns detected from the CTC Advisory Committee at the January 11, 2018 meeting, that the project was vetted properly. Chairman Arthur asked if there were any concerns from the full committee.

Hearing none Chairman Arthur entertained a motion that Spartanburg County CTC reaffirm their vote from January 18, 2018 that approved the use of Delegation set-a-side C Funds in the amount of \$181,489 for the Lake Lyman Heights Road widening and striping project.

Motion was made by John Throckmorton to reaffirm vote. Second was made by Dean Anderson.

Mr. Will Gramling, CTC member, asked if this vote was needed according to Roberts Rules. Chairman Arthur responded that there were some questions about the validity of the project, was the project needed and was it a good use of funds and he called the meeting so that Travis Brown could brief the committee on the scope of the project and the CTC could decide if they needed to retract or reaffirm their vote.

Hearing no further questions or discussion, by unanimous decision the committee reaffirmed their vote of January 18, 2018 to approve this project.

Chairman Arthur asked if there was any further questions or any other business that needed to be discussed. Hearing none Chairman Arthur asked for a motion to adjourn. Motion was made by John Throckmorton to adjourn. Second was made by Vic Bailey, IV. Motion carried and meeting was adjourned.
