### Public Health and Human Services Committee June 17, 2019

The Public Health and Human Services Committee of Spartanburg County Council met on Monday, June 17, 2019, in County Council Chambers of the County Administrative Office Building. - A. Mr. Troy M. Hanna, President & CEO, and Ms. Mary L. Thomas, Chief Operating Officer, presented information in reference to Spartanburg County Foundation's Center for Philanthropy. (Presentation included in backup) The Robert Hett Chapman III Center for Philanthropy will be the first center for philanthropy in the State of South Carolina. The purpose of the Robert Hett Chapman III Center for Philanthropy is to serve as a hub for innovative data driven solutions, thought leadership, and civic engagement that connects donors, nonprofit organizations and all individuals of Spartanburg County with the resources and tools needed to bring about transformative change. The Center will be located at 431 East Kennedy Street. It will be a 15,000 square foot building. The facility will fulfill the Foundation's immediate space needs. Additionally, it will become a collaboration space for donors, nonprofits, and the community at large. Additionally, a Partner in Residence will be housed at the Center for Philanthropy. The Partner in Residence will be named after John T. Wardlaw.
