- b. Upcoming special elections: April 27 for Lyman town council (Board meeting on April 29) ; June 8 for Reidville mayor (Board meeting on Jun 10).**
- c. Potential for another special election for Central Pacolet to fill 2 seats on town council.....reminder that Central Pacolet only has about 120 registered voters.**
- d. Legislative focus: H3444 passed the House and now is in Senate Judiciary Committee; changes to SEC from 5 members to 9 was stripped from bill. Objection to this bill is granting the SEC “plenary authority” (absolute authority) “to supervise and standardize the performance, conduct and practices of the county board of elections and voter registrations”. I have made our County delegation aware of the “plenary authority” wording. Senator Campsen (R – Charleston) objects to plenary authority as it diminishes home rule.....and SCARE objects to this as well.**
