AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 30-31 OF THE CODE OF THE COUNTY OF SPARTANBURG, SOUTH CAROLINA TO CHANGE THE TYPE OF WARNING PROVIDED BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT OR OTHER OFFICER FOR UNLAWFUL AMPLIFICATION AND TO AMEND SECTION 30-32 OF THE CODE OF THE COUNTY OF SPARTANBURG, SOUTH CAROLINA TO CHANGE THE TYPE OF WARNING PROVIDED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT OR OTHER OFFICIAL TO ABATE OR REDUCE NOISE.

WHEREAS, Section 30-31 of the Code of the County of Spartanburg contains provisions regarding unlawful amplification and requires certain notice be provided regarding operation or allowing operation of sound amplification equipment; and

WHEREAS, Section 30-32 of the Code of the County of Spartanburg contains provisions regarding a warning or request for abatement and requires certain notice be provided before a charge of violation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY SPARTANBURG COUNTY COUNCIL:


SECTION 1. Unlawful Amplification. Section 30-31 (1) of the Code of the County of Spartanburg, South Carolina is hereby amended by deleting the language "*warning, written or oral,*" and by substituting in its place the language "*a written warning*".

SECTION 2. Warning or Request for Abatement. Section 30-32 (b) of the Code of the County of Spartanburg, South Carolina is hereby amended by deleting the language "*The warning may be oral or in writing*" and by substituting in its place the language "*The warning must be in writing*".

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon third reading approval.
