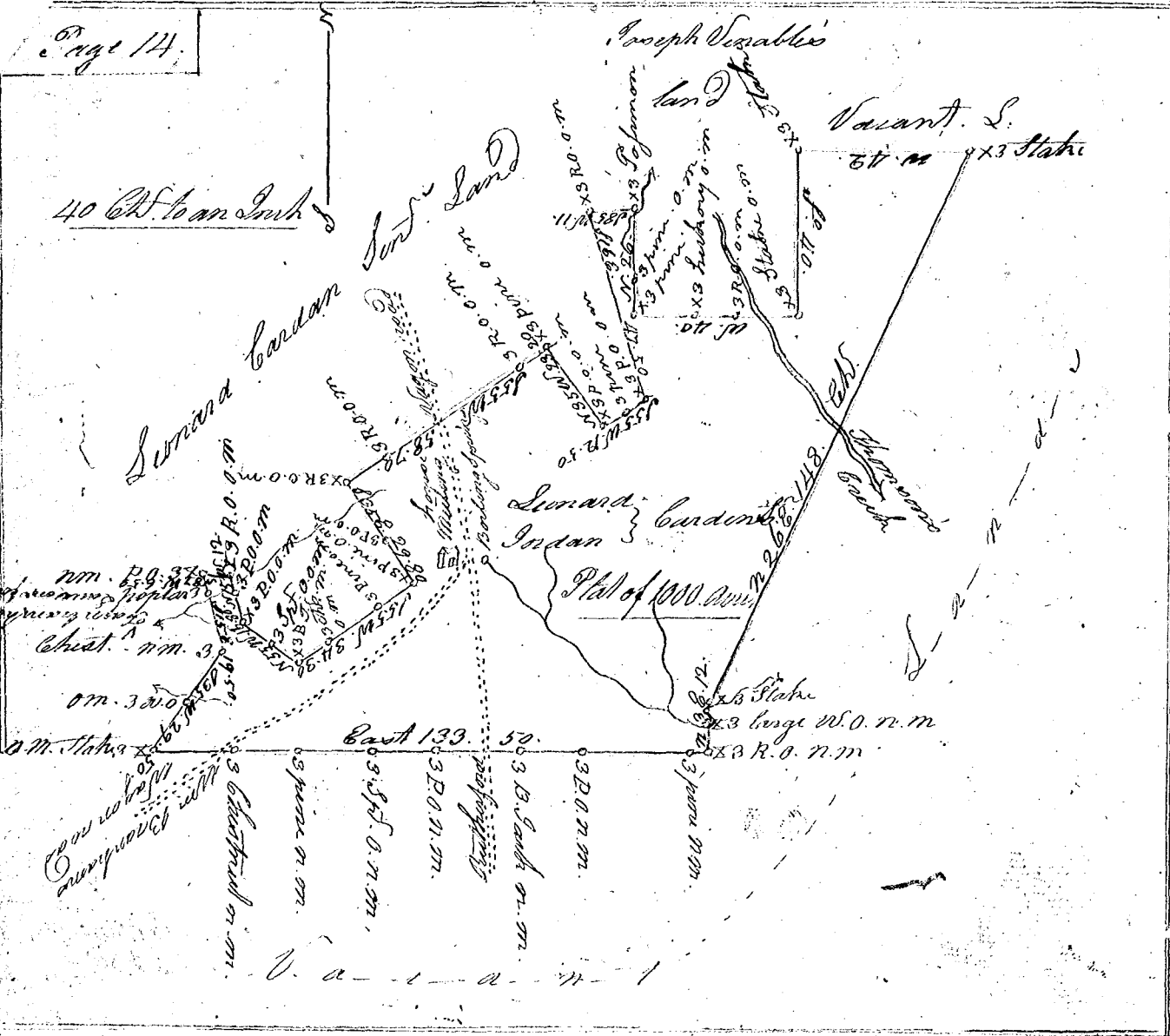

S.E. & N.W. by Leonard Jordan's land S.E. & S.W. by Garrison Clements land South West and North by Joseph Vezabelle's land all other sides Vacant land and hath with shape marks bearings & boundaries as the above plat Represents Surveyed the twelfth day of April 1802.
