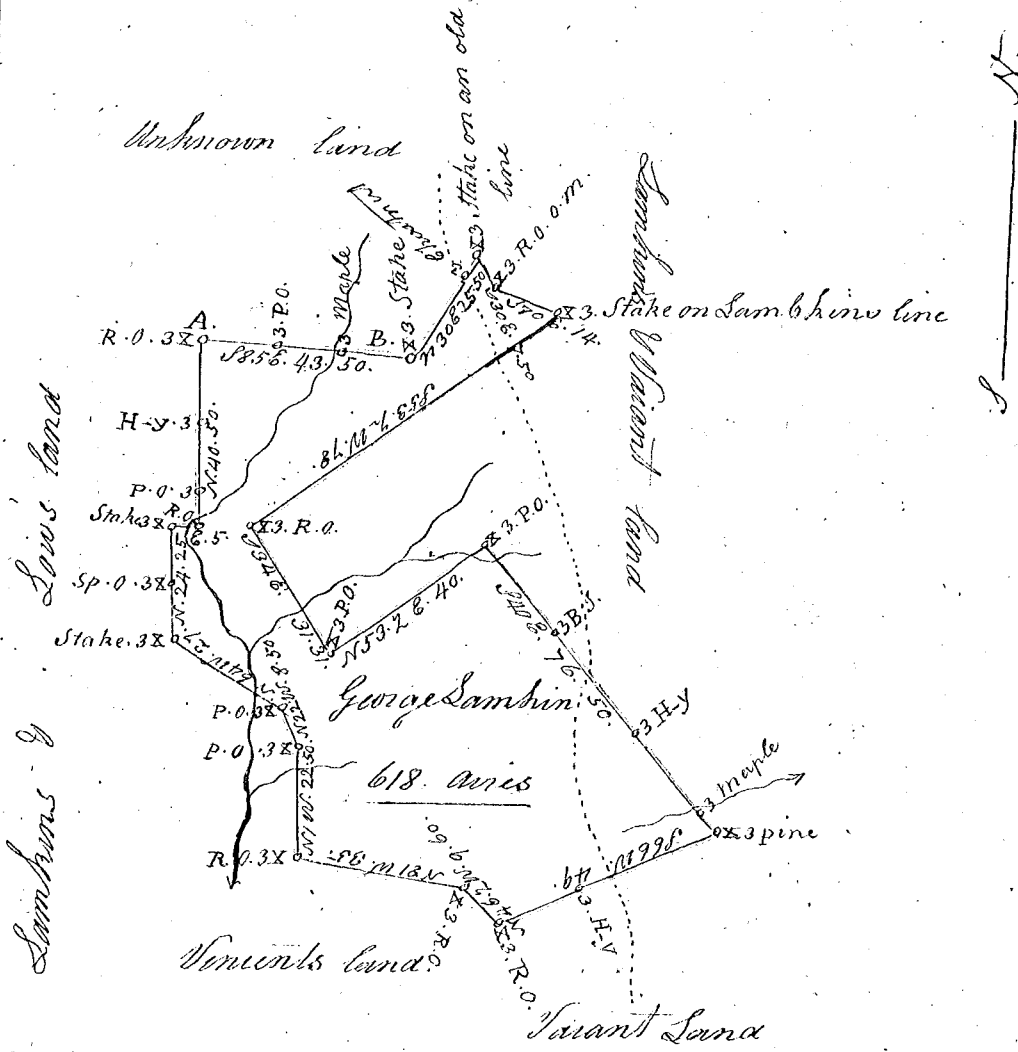

I have Survey'd for George Lambkin a tract of Six hundred and eighteen acres of land lying on the North side of Suckled river on small branches of the same bounded N<sup>o</sup> by unknown Land S<sup>o</sup> by Vincent's & Tenant's land East by said Lambkin's land & West by said Lambkins & Lows land & South such shape form and marked as the above plat represents Survey'd the 10<sup>th</sup> day of September 1803—
