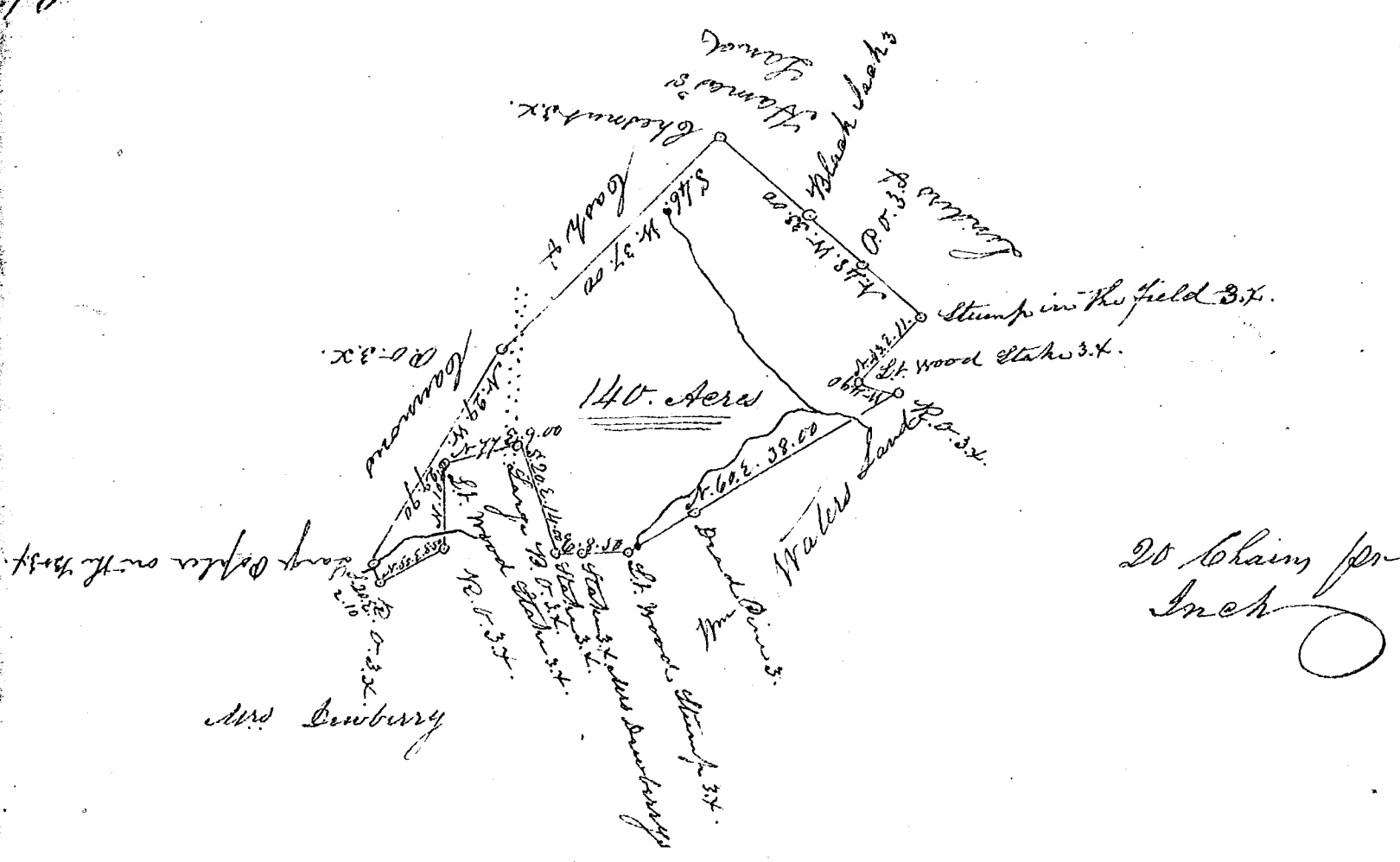

Pursuant to a warrant from Jabez Salt-egg, Commissioner of Locations, in the District of Spartanburgh, dated the 15<sup>th</sup> day of February 1837 - I have admeasured and laid out unto Robert Scruggs Junr, a tract of land containing one Hundred and forty Acres, situated in the said District, on the heads of Branches of Island Creek of Ocalet River and Rocky fork of Thickly Creek of Broad River bounded on the S.E. by ~~land~~ Mrs Durberry and Mr Waters, on the S.W. by Slinders and Hames and S.W. by Cash and Cannon's Land, and with such form and marks as the above Plat Represents -
