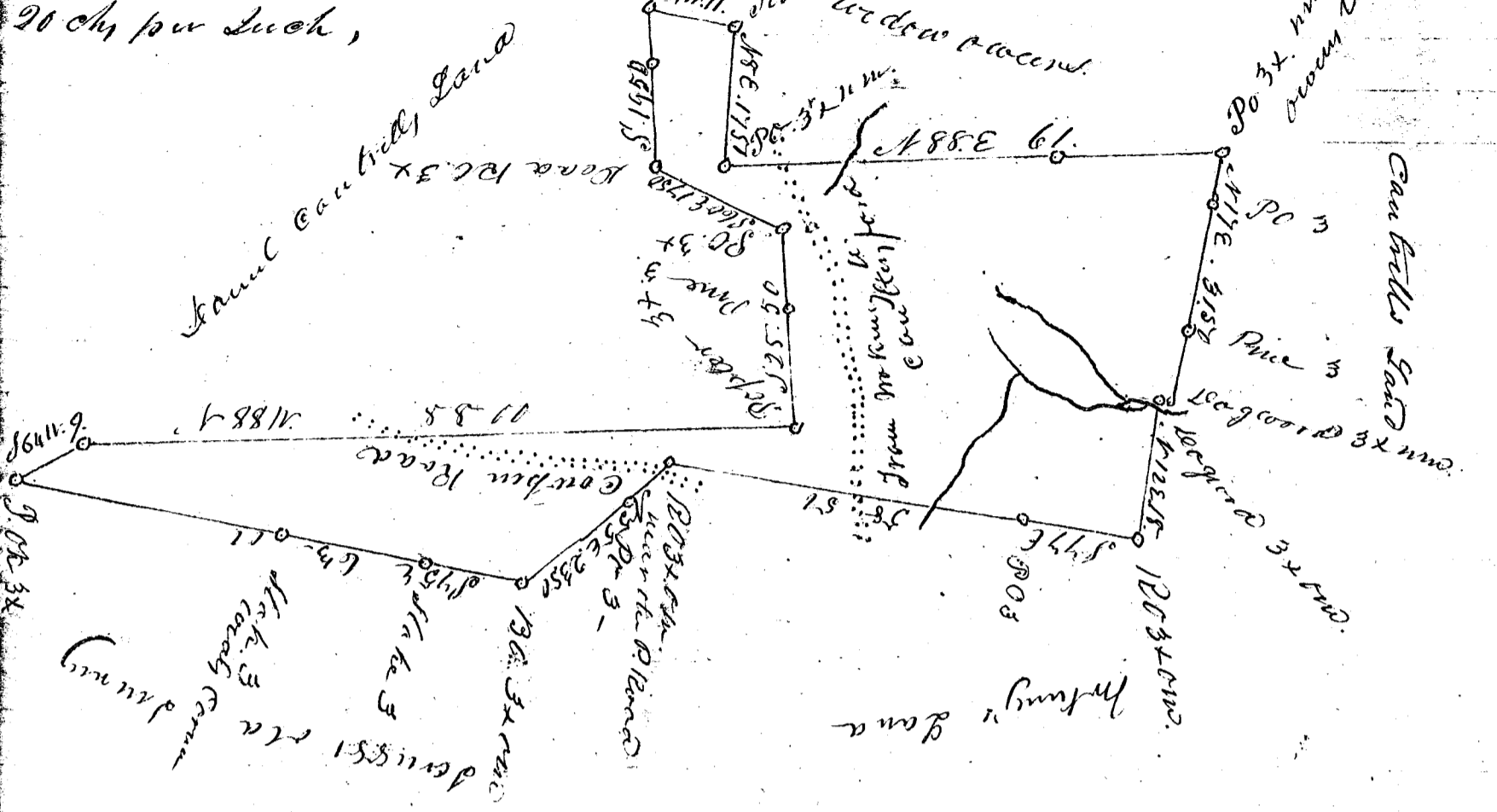

Pursuant to a warrant from James Salt Agent, Commissioner of Locations in the District of Spartanburg dated the twenty-ninth of October 1838, I have examined and laid out unto Robert Seruggs Sr. a tract of Land containing three hundred and thirtyfour acres, situated in the said District on the head branches of Buck Creek, waters of Pacolet River - bounded on the East side by Lands belonging to David Cantrell, on the South by Lands belonging to Mrs Owens - West by Lands belonging to - Cantrell, and North by William McKinny's Land, and Seruggs Land, and with such shape and form, as the above plat represents - Surveyed the 30th Oct 1838.
