Pursuant to a Warrant from James Galt Esq. Commissioner of Locations, in the District of Spartanburg dated the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of September 1839. I have admeasured and laid out unto A. C. Hardew a Tract of Two Hundred & Eighteen Acres of land situate in said District on a Small Branch called Colleys Branch waters of North Pacolet River and bounded by lines running S. E. by Mrs. Aunt's Land S. E. and N. W. by Therow Earls Land lands, and S. E. and S. W. by John Gains Land, having such form and marks buttings & boundings as the above plat represents —
