 measured and laid out unto John Meyer a tract of Land  
 containing thirty two acres, situated in the District of Spartanburg  
 and Union on Branches, of Cushman Creek water of Enore River  
 bounded by a line running S.E. by land surveyed for Legard Beck  
 now owned by A. G. Gordon S.W. by land now owned by Bird Hill  
 and not known to whom granted S.W. by land surveyed for  
 a man by the name of Head, now owned by A. G. Gordon  
 and hath such form and marks as the above plat represents  
 Surveyd the 14<sup>th</sup> day of February 1840
