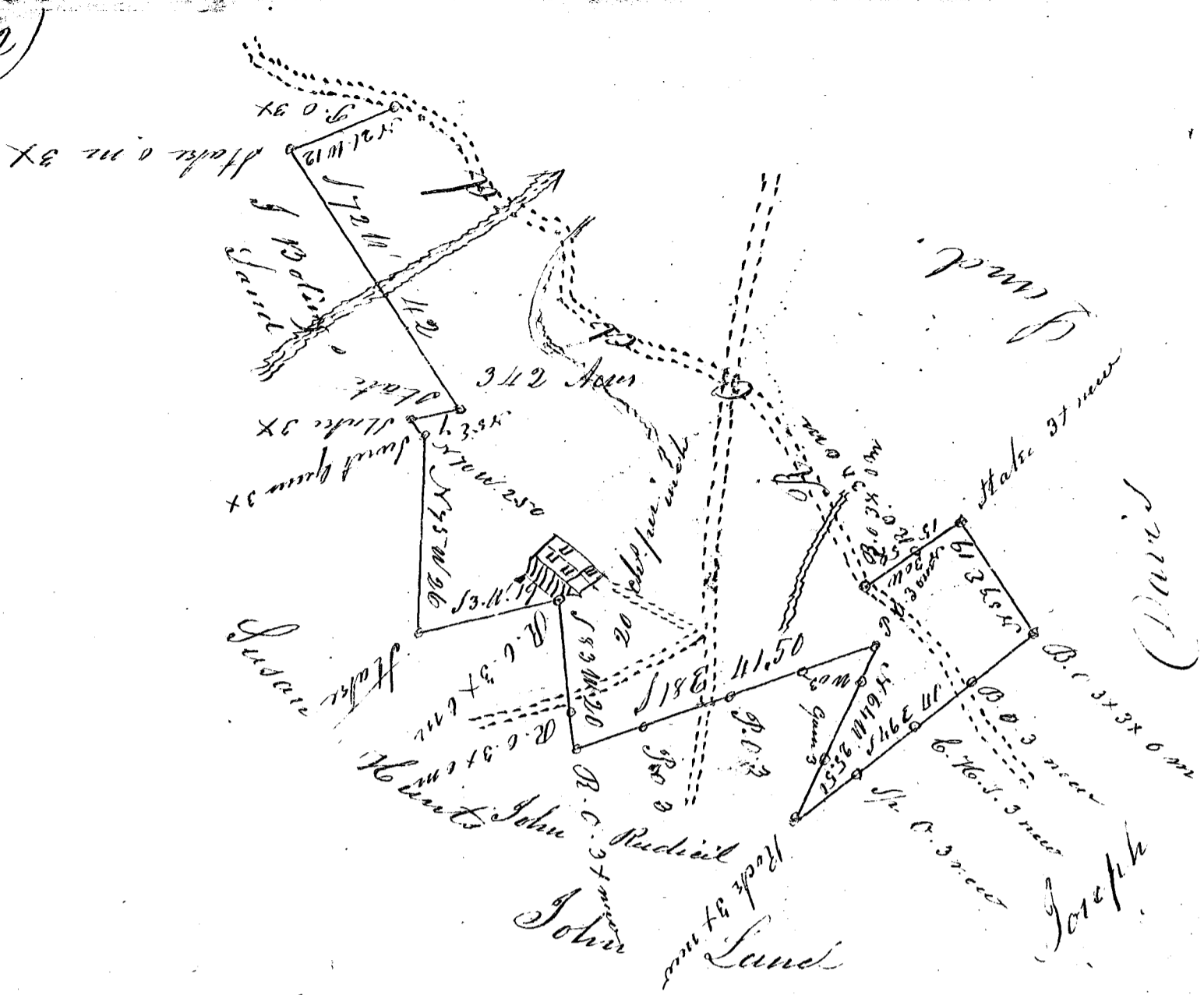

South Carolina

Pursuant to a Warrant for J. Tappan
 Commissioner of Locations in the District of Spartanburg
 dated the 12th day of November 1840. I have admeasured
 and laid out unto Anderson lively three hundred and
 forty two Acres of Land, situate, situate in said District
 on both sides of South Pacolet River, bounded by lines running
 S.E. and N.E. by Joseph Harises land, S.W. by J. Howlands
 land, S.E. & S.W. by Susan Hownts land, S.W. & S.E. by
 John Rudick's land, including a part of a tract formerly
 granted to Mathew Harper, and part of a grant
 originally granted to James Smith, which are now
 resurveyed for the purpose of obtaining a new grant,
 together with fifty acres, heretofore vacant, the whole
 having such form and marks as the above plat repre-
 sents.
