Pursuant to a Warrant from Joshua Tapp Egr. Clerk and Esq. Officer Commissioner of Locations in the District of Spartanburgh dated the fifth day of September 1842, I have admeasured and laid out unto Peyton S. Hunter a tract of land containing four hundred and eighty eight Acres situate in the said Dist. on the South Side of North Pacolet-River, bounded by lines Running S. W. & N. W. by Thomas Bryan, N. E. by J. Cleveland & John Chapmans and also by Jacksons & Bryans Road & North Pacolet-River, the above tract of land is composed of several parcels heretofore granted, and is now divided by this survey for the purpose of obtaining a new grant.
