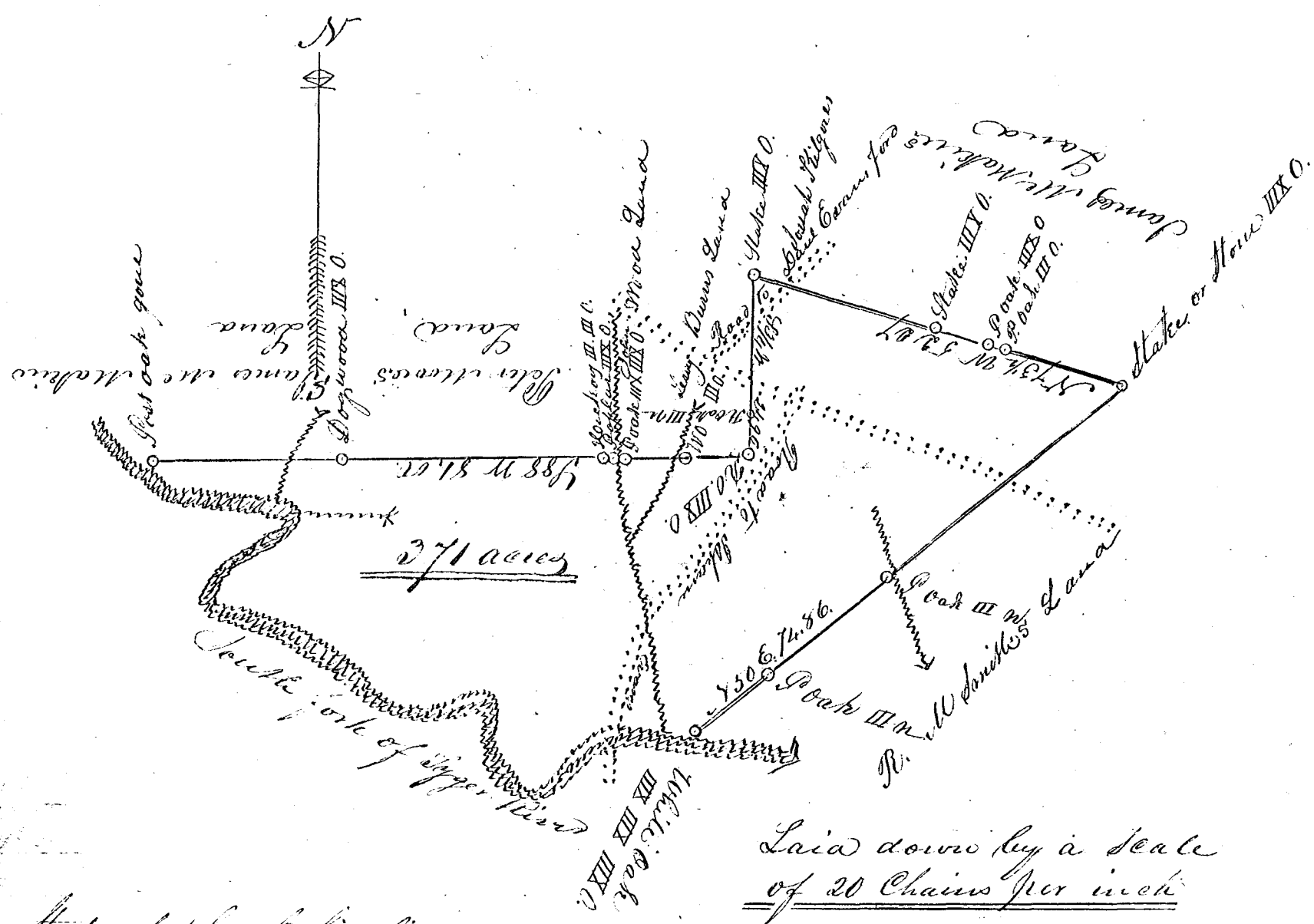


Robert Bailey's

1845) I have laid out unto Robert Bailey a tract of Land containing
Three Hundred and seventy one acres situated in the District & State
aforesaid on the North side of the South fork of Upper River &
bounded by lands belonging to R M Smith James McMath
Josiah Kilgour Leroy Dumas John Wood Peter Moore & said
River and Cash such marks & form as the above Plat
represents This Land has been formerly granted & this survey
is made for the purpose of obtaining a new grant and
covering vacant Land if any Resurveyed Dec. 9th 1845
