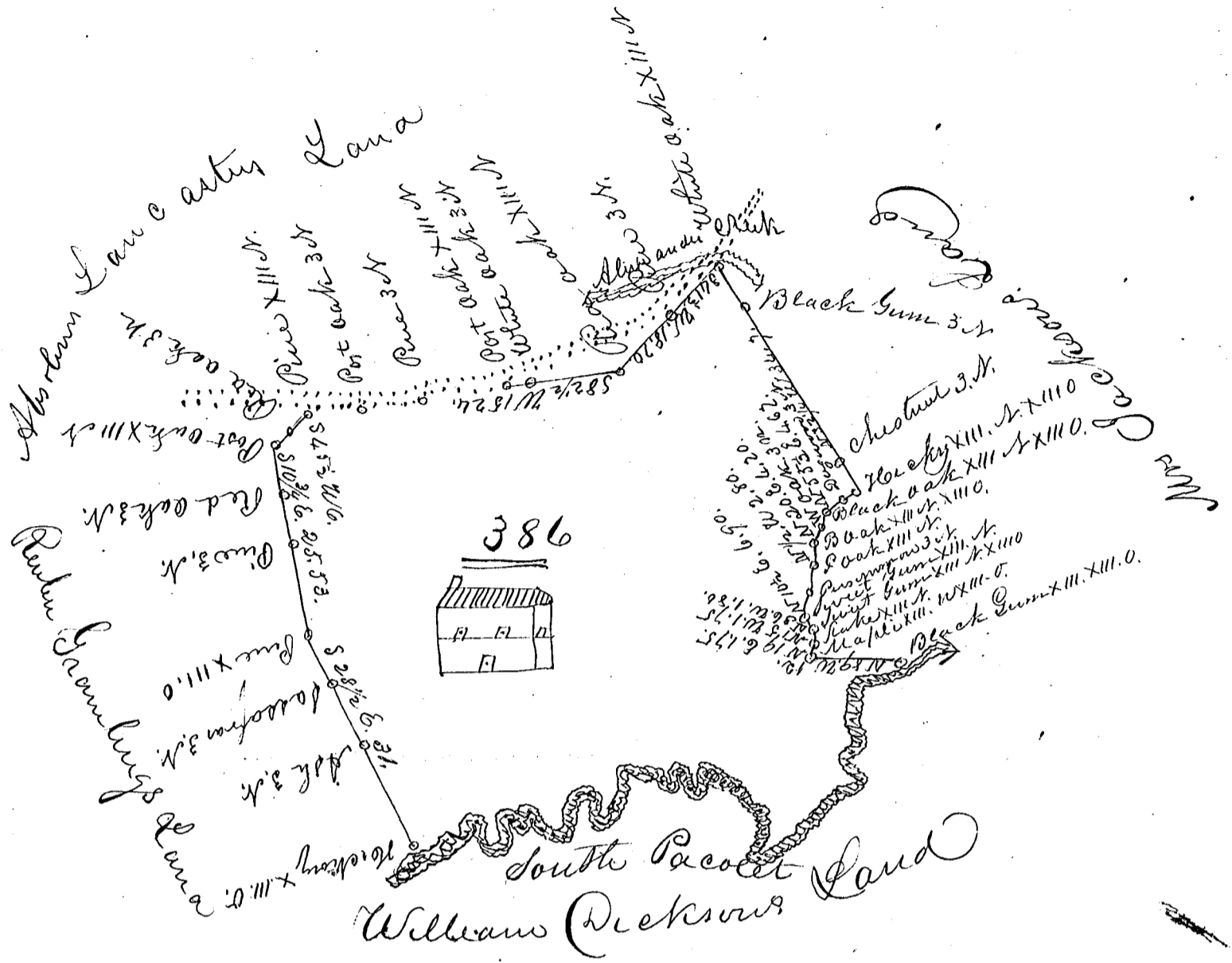


Arrow Cannon
Platt 386 Acres



South Carolina

Pursuant to a warrant from J. B. Tolleson
 Commissioner of Location in the district of Spartanburgh
 dated the fourth day of March 1848 I have resurveyed
 and laid out unto Arrow Cannon a tract of land
 containing 386 acres situated in the said district on South
 Pacolet. River this land was formerly granted and the survey
 which I now make is for the purpose of obtaining a new
 grant. It is bounded on the South by William Dickson's
 land on the S. E. by Ruben Grantling's land on the North
 & West, by Abraham Lancaster's land and on the East by Mrs.
 Jackson's land and hath such form and marks as the above
 plat represents. Resurveyed the 15. day of April 1848
