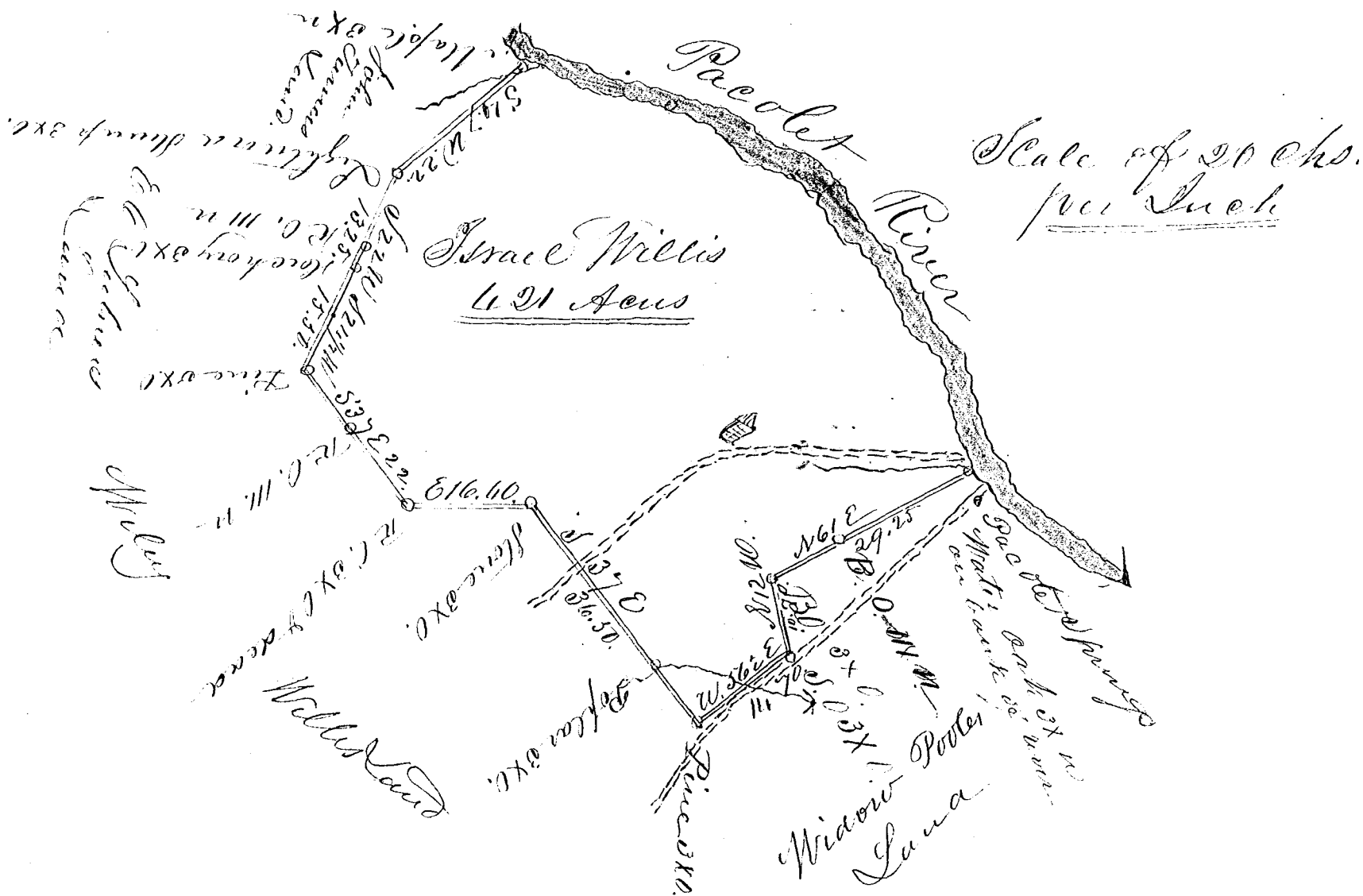


Isaac Willis

Location in the district aforesaid dated the 21<sup>st</sup> February  
1850. I have admeasured land laid out unto Isaac Willis  
a tract of Land containing of Four Hundred & twenty  
One acus. Situated in the State & district aforesaid on  
Pacolet River and bounded on the N. W. by John Turner  
W. & S. W. by lands of Col. Cole Litterer and Wiley Willis  
on the South & S. E. by lands of The Widow Lane  
and hath such form & marks, as is thus represented  
the object of the Survey is principally to regrant old  
granted land & include a small piece supposed  
to be vacant. Surveyed the 6<sup>th</sup> July 1850.
