Pursuant to a warrant from
W. Tolson Commissioner of Locations in the District of
Spartanburg, dated the 3rd day of March 1852 I have
acmeasured and laid out into John Nudisail, a
Tract of Land containing 755 acres situated in the said
District on the South Side of South Pacolet River, bounded
on the North by Lands of Metz Gullett, H. Parish and
Samuel Jackson, on the South by W. S. Hunt and A Line
- by lands, on the South by William Bowling, and Cleveland
lands, and on the West by John Archer and Samuel Lucas
land: and hath such form and marks as the above
plat represents. The above Tract of Land was formerly
granted and the Survey which I now make is for the
purpose of obtaining a new Grant.
