of Spartanburg dated the 11th day of February A. D. 1853.
I have admeasured and laid out unto William Smith
a Tract of Land containing 5 1/2 acres, situated in
the said District on both sides of Beaver Dam Creek
waters of South Piedmont River bounded on the N by
J. P. Davis Land, on the East by S. Jackson & A. P. Bobbs
Lands, on the South by Mrs. Guttetrey Land and on the
West by George Walker & J. P. Davis land, and hath
such form and marked as the above plat represents
all but a small part of the above tract of land
was originally granted, and this survey is made
for the purpose of obtaining a new grant
