Pursuant to a Warrant from A.B. Tolson Commissioner of Locations in the District of Spartanburg dated the 13th day of April 1850 I have admeasured and laid out unto John Brown a tract of land containing Four hundred & four acres, situated in Sevier District on the north side of Lawson's fork of Ducklet River and on both sides of Shady Creek bounded on the north & west by lands of Enoch Chapman and Wm Tyeck and on the South & East by John Bishop Wm Clements, Wm Harris & James Cannon and hath such form and marks as the above Plat represents. The same having been formally granted this is made to obtain a new Grant
