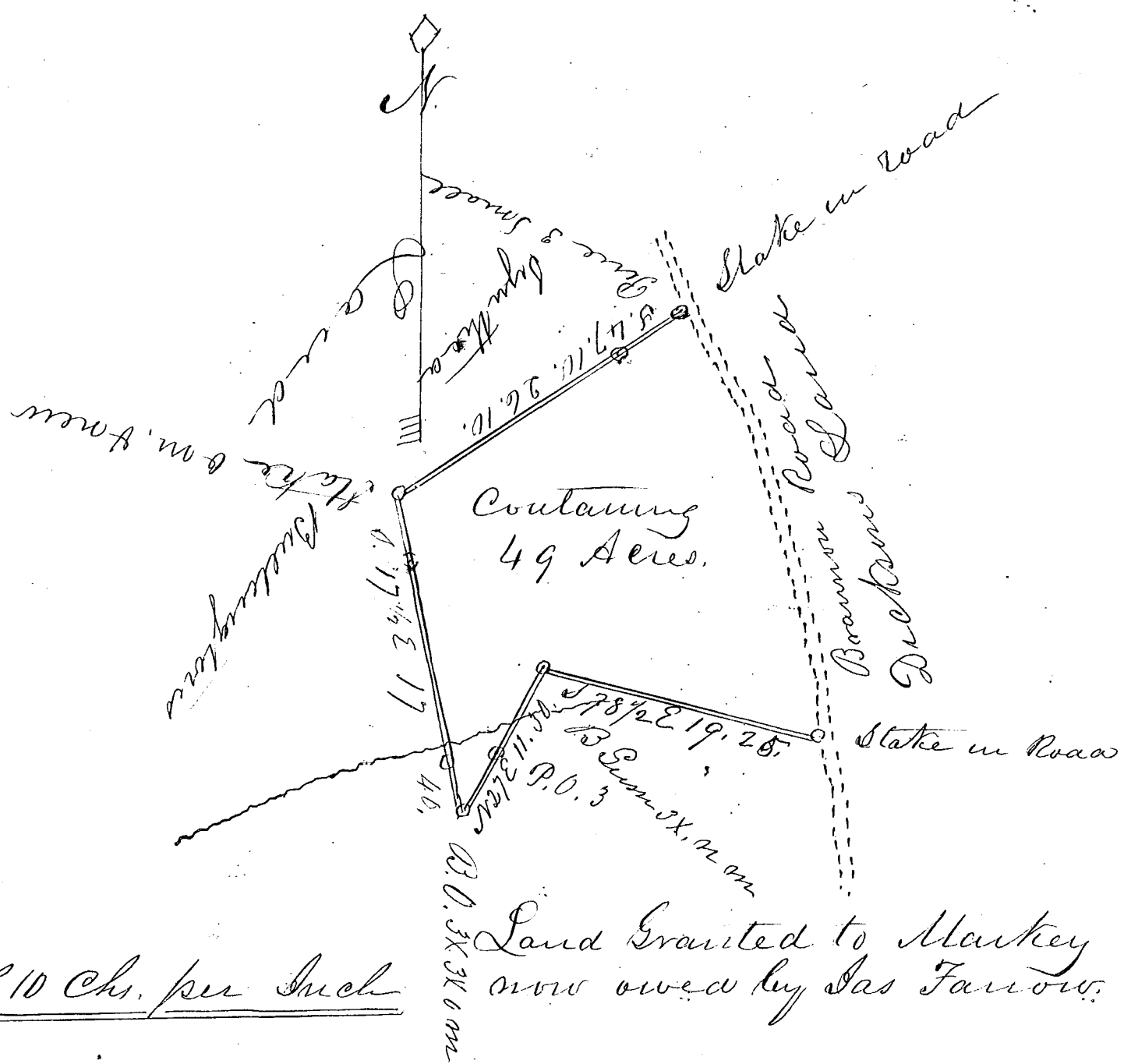


Oliver Clark's 254

Pursuant to a warrant from J. B. Tolleson, Commissioner of Location in the District of Spauldenburgh dated the 29th December 1854 I have admeasured & laid out unto May Oliver Clark a tract of land containing Forty nine acres situated in the said District out the waters of Lawrencefork of Peelet River bounded on the North by Synthetic Bullingtons land on the west by unknown lands on the south by land Granted to Markey & on the S. E. by land owed by Dickson and Chath such shape & marks as the above plat represents the object of this Survey is to obtain a Grant as we think the land is vacant, Surveyed Jan'y 2, 1855, by
